Application – All Customers

- A. Any person, firm, association, corporation or body politic or subdivision thereof located in the area served by the Central Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc., (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), may receive electric service as a member and /or patron from the Cooperative upon request. Membership may be obtained by application to receive electric service; provided, however, that no person, firm, association, corporation or body politic or subdivision thereof shall become a member unless and until he or it is receiving electric service and has been accepted for membership by the Board of Trustees or the Members. No member may hold more than one membership in the Cooperative and no membership in the Cooperative shall be transferrable.
- B. The Board of Trustees, by resolution, has provided that the Cooperative will provide electric service to the public in the areas where the facilities are certificated by the Commission under rules of general application with the privilege of membership available, but not required.
- C. The property owner and/or the lessee, tenant, or renter, is responsible to the Cooperative for obtaining any required right-of-way easements and permits from the designated source of connection to the applicant's point, or points, of connection with the right of ingress and egress thereto. Said right-of-way easements and permits shall be in the Cooperative's name granting authority for the Cooperative to place its facilities. The Cooperative may upon mutual agreement obtain said right-of-way easements and permits and the applicant shall be responsible for all associated costs and charges.
