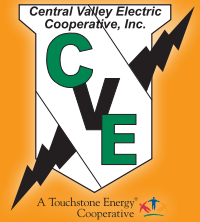

Commercial & Industrial Lighting

Did you know that Central Valley Electric Cooperative offers lighting rebates to commercial and industrial (C & I) members?

Rebates are available for C & I members who upgrade their existing lighting to more energy efficient lighting, or members who are building new facilities.

If you are interested in upgrading your lighting we can do a lighting assessment. We then send the lighting assessment to a company that will provide you with a lighting quote.
