- 3. Two (2) completed short essays written on the suggested topics. One (1) essay chosen by CVE and not limited to the number of words. One (1) essay is the applicant's choice from four (4) suggested topics and requires a minimum of 500 words.

In the event of an emergency, arrangements must be approved and will be coordinated through the New Mexico Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NMRECA). If a delegate cannot attend the entire Youth Tour, the delegate will be required to forfeit the trip and will become an alternate.
