#### **HVAC SYSTEM TUNE-UP**

**Energy Efficiency Program & Rebates** 

Central Valley Electric Cooperative promotes HVAC system tune-ups annually to help keep heating and cooling heat pump equipment operating optimally.

#### PROGRAM CONTENT

CVE provides residential members with a rebate on the performance of an HVAC tune-up by a licensed, qualified HVAC contractor.

#### **PROGRAM PROVISIONS**

#### **Program Qualifications & Restrictions:**

- 1. The HVAC tune-up must be performed in a permanent residence that CVE serves.
- 2. To qualify for a HVAC tune-up rebate, the home must be cooled by refrigerated air conditioning or heated with electric resistance heat or be a heat pump.
- 3. Members can apply for this rebate at the same address annually.

#### **HVAC Tune-Up Rebate**

 A rebate of forty percent (40% will be offered for the performance of an HVAC system tuneup by a licensed, qualified HVAC contractor (taxes not included).

#### **PROGRAM RULES & GUIDELINES**

- Must include a copy of a dated paid-in-full invoice from a licensed, qualified HVAC contractor.
- HVAC tune-up must be completed before a rebate can be issued.
- Members must apply for rebates within 90 days of getting the HVAC system tune-up. Rebates will be issued within 30 days of the approved application.

- Rebates will be given in the form of a check or utility bill credit.
- CVE does not guarantee a specific level of energy or cost savings will result from implementing or using products funded under this program.
- CVE is not liable for any damages caused by the operation or malfunction of the installed equipment.
- CVE reserves the right to inspect and verify that an HVAC system tune-up was performed.
- Rebates will be capped at \$75,000.00 annually for any one member. This amount applies to the combined total of all other CVE rebate programs.
- To receive the rebate, CVE members must be current (within 60 days) in the payment of their account(s).

#### PROGRAM FUNDING

Funding for this program comes from CVE's Renewable Energy and Energy Conservation Fund. Should this fund become deficient, the HVAC System Tume-Up program will become inactive until such time funds are available.
